Dear Secretary Avisado:

May we refer to the Government Quality Management Committee (GQMC) Advisory No. 2020-1 dated December 9, 2020 relative to Posting of Supporting Document to the Valid ISO Quality Management System (QMS) Requirements for the Grant of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 Performance-Based Bonus (PBB).

The DENR Quality Management System's Registration has a validity until March 27, 2022. The Surveillance Audit of the DENR QMS for 2020 was conducted by SOCOTEC Certification Philippines, Inc. (formerly AJA Registrars) as scheduled, on January 13 to 17, 2020 covering a system-wide implementation of DENR frontline and support services in the Central Office, four (4) staff bureaus and three (3) pilot regions, PENROs and CENROS (Region II, Region VII and Region XI). The said audit was conducted prior to CoVid 19 and was a regular assessment of DENR's conformity to ISO 9001:2015. Further, the 2nd Surveillance Audit has been conducted by SOCOTEC through remote/virtual audit last January 18 to 22, 2021, attesting to the validity of the DENR's QMS as of December 31, 2020 as required by IATF Memorandum Circular No. 2020-1.
