Phl metallic mineral production up 30%

The value of the country's metallic output expanded by nearly 30 percent in the three quarters ending September, owing to higher output and prices of nickel and gold, the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) said.

Metallic mineral production remained upbeat as its value rose by 29.21 percent to P175.61 billion.

"The important factors for this development were the bullish metal prices of nickel ore and gold, paired with the increased mine output of gold, silver, chromite and iron ore during the period," the MGB said.

Prices of nickel ore went up by 47.2 percent to \$11.97 per pound.

MGB said the nine-month price of nickel was still above the 2018-2021 levels, with prices peaking in March at \$17.14 per pound while the third quarter average settled at \$10.02 per pound.

China is the Philippines' major trading partner for nickel ore.

Gold also saw a 1.36 percent price increase from \$1,801.97 per troy ounce to \$1,826.47 year-on-year, based on the Bangko Sentral Ng Pilipinas (BSP) price bulletin. Its nine-month average went up from \$1,801.97 per troy ounce to \$1,826.47, even as its third quarter average price was lower year-on-year.

On the other hand, both silver and

copper prices dipped by 14.84 percent and 0.64 percent, respectively.

MGB data showed nickel ore, together with its nickel by-products – mixed nickel-cobalt sulfide (MNCS) and scandium oxalate – continued to have the largest share at 49.4 percent, contributing P86.94 billion.

Gold came in second, cornering 38.32 percent and raking in P67.45 billion.

Copper took the third spot, accounting for 10.79 percent with a value of P18.99 billion

The collective value of silver, chromite and iron ore contributed about 1.49 percent of the total at P2.63 billion – the first time that the joint values of these three commodities exceeded the P1-billion mark.

MGB said a big factor was the increased output of TVI Resource Development (Phils) Inc.'s Balabag gold-silver project from 1,170 kilograms with an estimated value of P41.26 million to 19,088 kilograms with an estimated value of P736.76 million.

"Overall, there was a remarkable increase in the value of mineral commodities year-on- year," the agency said.

In terms of regional contribution, the MGB data showed the Caraga region cornered 37.26 percent of the total production valued at P65.57 billion.

It was followed by Mimaropa with 11.19 percent at P19.69 billion and Cagayan Valley with 10.58 percent at P18.62 billion.

In terms of the number of operating

metallic mines in a region, the MGB data showed Caraga remained as the country's mining hub, with two gold mines, one chromite mine, 18 nickel mines, one hydrometallurgical processing plant and a gold processing plant.

For the period, BSP gold purchases amounted to about P16.36 billion, with

five gold buying stations strategically located across the country.

Meanwhile, nickel direct shipping ore declined by 17 percent in volume from 27,238,874 dry metric tons to 22,525,878 DMT. However, it recorded a two-percent increase in terms of value from P45.97 billion to P46.82 billion.

The government plans to tap the potential of the mining sector to push for the country's economic growth through the declaration of more Minahang Bayan.

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Higher prices push mineral prod'n value

METALLIC mineral production value jumped 29.21 percent in the first nine months of 2022 to P175.61 billion from P136.21 billion in the same period in 2021, according to the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB).

MGB attributed this to higher metal prices of nickel ore and gold paired with increased mine output of gold, silver, chromite and iron ore.

In a report, MGB said nickel ore and its nickel by-products, mixed nickel-cobalt sulfide and scandium oxalate continued to have the largest share with P86.94 billion or 49.40 percent.

This was followed by gold with P67.45 billion or 38.32 percent and copper, P18.99 billion or 10.79

The combined mine value of silver, chromite and iron ore accounted for P2.63 billion or 1.49 percent.

In terms of production, gold improved by 16.7 percent to 21,836 kilograms (kg) from 18,715 kg; silver surged by 131 percent to 41,710 kg from 18,045 kg; copper went up by 22 percent to 190,767 dry met-

ric tons (dmt) from 156,864 dmt; chromite jumped 828.7 percent to 100,447 dmt from 10,816 dmt; and iron ore increased by 51 percent to 57,040 dmt from 37,785 dmt.

Direct shipping ore nickel was the only component that experienced a decrease in production, by 17 percent to 27.24 million dmt from 22.53 million dmt.

The average price of nickel ore for the period surged by 47.21 percent to \$11.97 per lb from \$8.13 per lb while gold increased by 1.36 percent to \$1,825.47 per troy

ounce from \$1,801.97 per troy ounce.

Copper prices dipped by 0.64 percent to \$4.12 per lb from \$4.15 per lb while silver prices went down by 14.84 percent to \$21.94 per troy

ounce from \$25.77 per troy ounce.

The MGB said metal prices could have dropped in the fourth quarter and will likely go down up to 2023 due to weaker global growth and concerns over a slowdown

in China's demand due to its zero COVID policy.

The agency said t prices are still expected to remain higher than their average over the past five years. - Jed Macabagal

Trapped Kalinga miner meets tragic end

BAGUIO CITY—Authorities from the Pasil Municipal Police Station reported that a miner who was trapped in a rubble inside the "minahang bayan" of Sitio Magadgad, Barangay Galdang, Pasil in Kalinga.

The miner was identified as Milnar Wail Bag-ayan, a resident of Barangay Galdang. His remains were recovered at 6 a.m. of 4 December.

Reports from the Pasil Municipal Police Station disclosed that it has responded to a call from the barangay local government unit of Galdang informing them of a trapped miner due to eroded boulders in a mine site at the Minahan ng Bayan at Sitio Magadgad.

Search and Rescue team from the Pasil Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Council proceeded to the area but was met by civilian rescue volunteers who were able to recover the victim's body.

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DEADLY SPRUCE EATERS

HELSINKI—Deep in the Finnish woods, the moss and blueberry shrubs hide a deadly threat to the boreal forests that are as important to the planet as the Amazon rain forest.

With chunks of their bark peeling off and needles falling from dying branches, more and more trees are being killed by the spruce bark beetle, which is venturing further and further north with climate change.

The tiny brown insects attack the Picea abies, one of Finland's most common tree species, and can cause massive damage to forests.

Burrowing through the bark to lay their eggs, the beetles eat their way around the spruce and kill it by stopping water and nutrients reaching the higher branches.

"The species has caused

huge damage across Central spruce, while warm winters and Eastern Europe, especially since 2018," Markus Melin, a scientist at the Natural Resources Institute Finland, told Agence France-Presse (AFP).

With climate change, the risk of the beetle spreading is a "lot higher now," Melin added.

"We have to accept it and adapt to it. Things are changing fast up here."

While the threat is greatest in southern Finland, the sweltering summer of 2021 saw bark beetle damage "unusually high up north" in the Kainuu region of northern Finland.

"It is well known that the spruce bark beetle is one of the species that benefit most from global warming," Melin said.

The beetles thrive on weakened trees. Hot summers mean there are more water-starved mean there is no frozen ground to brace the trees against storms.


Warm weather also speeds up the life cycle of the beetles, meaning they can reproduce faster.

"Extreme warm summers benefit the bark beetle directly. They have less mortality, reproduction is faster," Melin said.

While the beetles normally go for weak trees, once their numbers reach a tipping point they can start attacking healthy ones.

"It becomes a nasty loop," Melin said.

If foresters do not react in time by removing weakened spruce, "suddenly there are so many beetles that they can attack healthy trees" further speeding the "cycle of destruction," Melin said. -AFP

"The CA also did not give credence to CEC-P's study. The CA noted that CEC-P already had a conclusion in mind when it conducted its study at Villar's behest as it deliberately ignored the ECC and the studies conducted by DCCD Engineering Corp. (DCCD), Surbana International Consultants PTE Ltd. (Surbana), and DHI Water & Environment (S) Pte. Ltd. (DHI). The CA also noted that CEC-P relied on the EPRMP submitted in August 2010 and not the final EPRMP Alltech submitted in December 2010, making its findings inaccurate and unreliable.31

"The CA also held that the precautionary principle, which shifts the burden of proof to the project proponent to prove that the threat to the environment does not exist, cannot be favorably applied to Villar's cause. The CA explained that the threat was not established and that the volumes of data generated by objective and expert analyses ruled out the scientific uncertainty of the nature and scope of the anticipated threat. Thus, the CA was not convinced that sufficient ground exists to grant the privilege of

the writ of kalikasan.
