PROCUREMENT OF TWO (2) UNITS OF BRAND-NEW PICK-UP TRUCK FOR THE FOREIGN ASSISTED AND SPECIAL PROJECTS SERVICE

I. RATIONALE

The Foreign Assisted and Special Projects Service is responsible in overseeing the development, programming and evaluation of project proposals for foreign assistance and special funding, conduct of pre-implementation activities, and management of all FASPs. In addition, provision of technical assistance/linkaging to our development partners but more importantly to our oversight agencies not to mention our field implementing units, i.e. doing validation and monitoring works. Majority of our projects are located in the mountainous regions and rugged terrain of Cordillera as well as in Cagayan Valley.

The procurement of pick-up is deemed necessary which can endure the varying road conditions and easy mobility to the project sites/areas.

1. The brand being offered for the Pick-up Truck must be sold and marketed continuously in the Philippine Market for the last **twenty-five (25) years**.
2. Valid and current certificate of automotive Distributorship or Dealership issued in the name of the Bidder by the manufacturer. If not directly issued by the manufacturer to the Bidder, must also submit/include valid and correct Certificate of Distributorship or Dealership that will link bidder to the manufacturer.
3. Brochure (original or internet download/Technical Data Sheet or equivalent) of the Pick-up Truck being offered showing compliance to the technical specifications.
4. List of Company-Owned or Franchise Service Center in the Philippines with available spare parts, indicating address, telephone and fax numbers, email address and contact person.
5. Must ensure availability of service centers within Luzon area.
6. Certificate of Performance Evaluation with a rating of at least Satisfactory issued by the Largest Contract's Client/s of the bidder as specified in its Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) Form.
7. Submit Certificate of Spare Parts Availability in the Philippines for the next five (5) years after expiration of the Warranty Period issued by the manufacturer

C. The bidders must comply with the following conditions:

1. If awarded, the winning bidder shall enter into a service level agreement covering the preventive maintenance service within the warranty period.
2. Delivery site is at the DENR-Central Office through the Property and Supply Management Division, Basement, DENR Main Building, Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City.
3. The delivered Pick-up Truck shall be subjected to testing, functional testing and road readiness conducted by the Inspection Team from the DENR and representative from the Foreign Assisted and Special Projects Service (FASPS).
4. Free LTO registration for the first three (3) years, and 1 year GSIS Comprehensive, Third-Party Liability (TPL) insurance. Units shall be registered under the name of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.
5. The delivered Pick-up Truck shall have this vehicle marking, "DENR Logo, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, For Official Use Only" on the driver and front passenger doors.
6. Warranty shall cover the following, including but not limited to engine and chassis from date of Certificate of Inspection and Acceptance issued by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR).

 - (ii) Copy of Protocol/Undertaking of Agreement to Enter into Joint Venture (Annex V) signed by all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful and must be in accordance with Section 23.1 (b) of the IRR
In case the joint venture is not yet in existence, the submission of a valid JVA shall be within ten (10) calendar days from receipt by the bidder of the notice from the BAC that the bidder is the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid [Sec 37.1.4 (a) (i)]
- (h) **The JVA or the Protocol/Undertaking of Agreement to Enter into Joint Venture (per Annex V) must include/specify the company/partner and the name of the office designated as authorized representative of the Joint Venture.**

ENVELOPE 2: FINANCIAL COMPONENT

- (a) Completed and signed Financial Bid Form. Bidder must use, accomplish and submit Bid Form (Annex VI); **and**
(b) Original of duly signed and accomplished Price Schedule(s) (Annex VI-A or VI-B).

The ABC is inclusive of VAT. Any proposal with a financial component exceeding the ABC shall not be accepted.
