“The DENR will be at the frontlines of ensuring that the verdant forest covers will be replenished to ensure adequate carbon sequestration to meet the country’s contributions to sustain the goal of the Paris Agreement,” DENR Secretary Roy Cimatu said in a release.

For the Glasgow pledge to work, the Philippine government must craft a local declaration that will support it, WWF-Philippines Forests for Water program manager Paolo Pagaduan stressed.

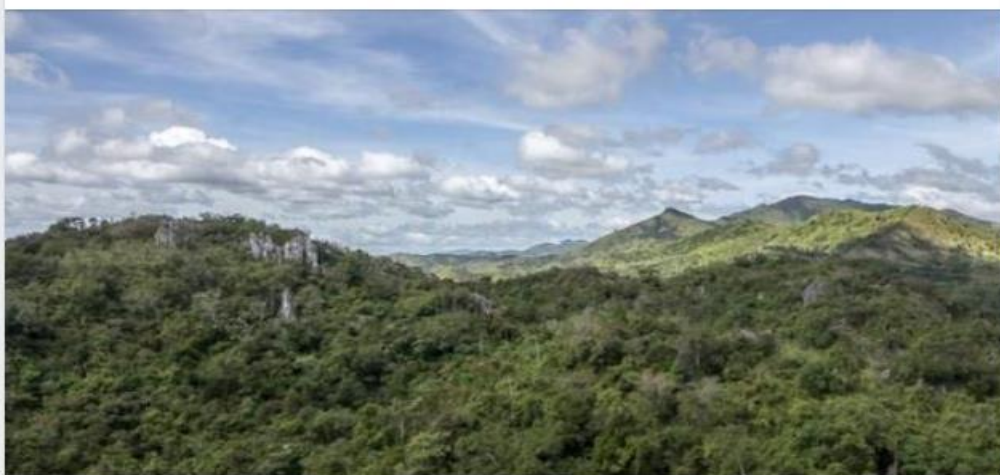
“A supporting policy document to the COP26 deforestation pledge that stops all deforestation in the country would be a monumental achievement for the Philippines. In it, we have to articulate what we mean by stopping deforestation and how to achieve it before 2030,” Pagaduan said.

He added that in a country where forests are cleared for agricultural activities or development projects, there is a need to properly balance environment protection and economic interests in land-use policies.

Data from DENR’s Forest Management Bureau showed the Philippines, one of the severely deforested countries in the tropics, had a little over 7 million hectares of forest left in 2015. Ninety percent of the archipelago was believed to be covered by forests in the 16th century.

"It boils down to the land because forests will not fully thrive and be able to provide all its benefits for nature, biodiversity, and the climate on the same space as agricultural fields, real estate, or other infrastructure developments," Pagaduan said."

## After 5 years, PH has a newly-hatched Philippine eagle

DAVAO CITY — The Philippine Eagle Foundation (PEF) welcomed the 29th successfully bred chick at the Philippine Eagle Center on Saturday (December 4).

In a statement on Monday (December 6), the PEF said, “Chick 29” hatched at 1:16 pm. The chick is under close monitoring of the PEF’s Conservation Breeding Program.

The egg was laid last October 10 by female eagle Ariela with her male natural pair MVP Matatag; both are rescued eagles from the wild.

“The chick started to pip at 12:03 pm on December 3 and took over 24 hours before it completely broke out of its egg,” the PEF added.

To date, the PEF said, “this was the fastest pip-to-hatch record in the PEF’s breeding program.”

Ariela and MVP Matatag were first introduced for pairing in February 2019, the PEF added. The Ariela Marketing Company, Inc. adopted Ariela in 2015, while PLDT adopted MVP Matatag in 2017.

In an interview, PEF Executive Director Dennis Salvador said it took about five years before another eagle egg hatched at the PEC. The Philippine Eagle named Sakura was hatched in 2016. Sakura, however, died from a snakebite at the PEC.

Pag-asa (Hope), the first Philippine eagle bred in captivity, was hatched in 1992. The eagle died before his 29th birthday on January 6 this year.

Salvador said the successful hatching of “Chick 29” is “important because many of our old breeding birds have retired, and we’ve been working on new ones.”

“It took us this long for those pairings to work,” he said.

Salvador also described it as “a culmination of all our hard work and perseverance in an incredibly tough time in the conservation mission.”

“We share this milestone with the Filipino people who have supported us through their donations and helped keep the PEC a safe home for our national bird amid the COVID-19 pandemic,” he said.

Salvador said another egg is now under incubation at the PEC.

“Hopefully, it turns out to be fertile. We’ll know after a couple of weeks,” Salvador added.





## 29th Philippine eaglet hatched after 5 years

DAVAO CITY , Philippines — The Philippine Eagle Center (PEC) produced the 29th Philippine eaglet bred in captivity five years after Sakura, the last eaglet, was hatched at the Center in Barangay Malagos, Calinan district, this city.

The new eaglet is an offspring of parents Ariela, a female Philippine Eagle adopted by Ariela Marketing Co. in 2015, and the male MVP Matatag, adopted by Philippine Long Distance Telecommunications Corp. in 2017.

The late eagle Pag-asa was the first ever Philippine Eagle bred in captivity that was hatched by the PEC in 1992. At least 27 other eaglets were later produced by the PEC under its captive breeding program until the hatching of the 29th eaglet last Saturday.

The PEC's captive breeding program was not able to produce any eaglet over the past five years because the eagles at the center's gene pool have grown old. Eagles Ariela and MVP Matatag are from a younger batch of raptors.

The hatching of the 29th eaglet is a welcome development, as the population of the Philippine Eagle, the country's national bird, continues to dwindle, with only less than a thousand including those sighted in the wild.



## 29th Philippine eaglet hatched after 5 years

According to Dennis Salvador, executive director of the non-profit Philippine Eagle Foundation (PEF), “Chick No. 29” was hatched on Dec. 4 at 1:16 p.m., 25 hours and 13 minutes since it first poked

its beak and cracked the egg. The eaglet’s pip-to-hatch time is reportedly the fastest on record in the PEC’s captive-breeding program.

“The hatching of this chick is a culmination of all our hard work and perseverance in an incredibly tough time in the conservation mission. We share this milestone with the Filipino people who have supported us through their donations and helped keep the PEC a safe home for our national bird amid the COVID-19 pandemic,” Salvador said.

Salvador shared that the egg was laid on Oct. 10, 2021. Both Ariela and MVP Matatag are rescued eagles from the wild and were first introduced for pairing in February 2019. They are one of the three Philippine Eagle natural pairs under the care of the PEF.

“The steadfast support of our Philippine Eagle adopters is invaluable. Their years of trust and generosity bolstered the crucial work of our keepers at the PEC that led to this hatching,” added Salvador.

The chick is kept in the PEC’s incubation and rearing laboratory and is closely monitored around the clock by members of the PEF’s Conservation Breeding Program.

## Dumagat tribe gets P20M aid from MWSS

MORE than 5,500 members of the Dumagat tribe in Bulacan will benefit from the P20 million aid from the Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System (MWSS).

According to MWSS administrator [Leonor Cleofas](#), the said financial assistance is from the community royalty from the Tunnel 4 project of the Angat Water Transmission Improvement.

He said this is an obligation of the MWSS to the indigenous people of Dumagat because the Angat Dam and Ipo Dam are the source of the water that is supplied to Bulacan, [Metro Manila](#), Rizal and Cavite.

These two dams in Norzagaray are sheltered in the Kabayunan Ancestral Domain of the Dumagat.

With the help of the [National Commission](#) on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP), the [Indigenous Bulos Kabulowen Association Community of Bulacan](#) (IBKACB), an association of the Dumagat people living in the said ancestral domain, has set up an account with the [Land Bank](#) of the [Philippines](#).

It is the responsibility of IBKACB to implement the expenditure of funds through the Resource Development and Management Plan developed by [the tribe](#) themselves.

Also included here are three units of multipurpose vehicles that can carry 15 to 20 people, and 10 sets of motorcycles with sidecar popularly known here as kolang-kolang.

[Regina Panlilio](#), head of the [NCIP-Bulacan Service Center](#), said the vehicles can be used to facilitate their trading products such as Dumagat's agricultural crops from mountains down to the markets.

It will also serve as a service vehicle for indigenous students for possible face-to-face classes, transporting patients to the hospital and even attending training and workshops.

Twenty scholarship slots for students taking a four-year course in college have also been given to the Dumagat people.

Panlilio explained that although education at state universities and colleges is free, the scholarships are in addition to the potential beneficiaries such as pocket money, purchase of equipment and other study needs.

Also allocated is P200,000 for each qualified beneficiary as a startup fund for a livelihood project.

Eight boats were also given to the Dumagat fisherfolk living near the said dams.

There is also a plan to add 12 forest guards and build 10 tribal halls as gathering facilities for the tribe.

Meanwhile, in conjunction with the launch of community royalty-funded projects from MWSS, the new location and office of the NCIP-Bulacan Service Center was also inaugurated inside the Tunnel 4 compound in Barangay Bigte in Norzagaray.

It will serve as a gateway and liaison for the Dumagat if they have a need that the government must address immediately.





## Thousands of turtles lay eggs on Nicaraguan coast

SAN JUAN DEL SUR, Nicaragua — Thousands of sea turtles laid their eggs on Nicaragua's coast over the weekend under the watchful eye of the army, which protects the nests from possible predators — including humans.

The olive ridley sea turtles (*Lepidochelys olivacea*) migrate for long distances to spawn between July and January in the Pacific coast wildlife refuges of La Flor and Chacocente, areas where the endangered species is protected against predators that plunder its nests.

La Flor beach, in San Juan del Sur, is a tourist destination in southern Nicaragua. It is an ideal location for the olive ridley turtle to nest due to its tropical climate and warm waters, which encourage reproduction, according to environmentalists.

The turtle species, which as an adult measures a little more than half a meter (1.5 feet) long and weighs about 38 kilograms (84 pounds), can lay about 90 eggs in 24 hours. The incubation process takes 40 to 70 days.

Authorities at Nicaragua's Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment estimate that for every 100 turtles that hatch, 90 enter the sea, but only three make it to adulthood.

The environmental authorities are implementing a sea turtle conservation plan in partnership with the army to prevent neighboring communities from raiding the nests.

The olive ridley, distinguished by its olive green color, is one of five turtle species that nest in Nicaragua, in addition to the green, hawksbill, loggerhead and leatherback sea turtles.

## 35% of Filipinos fully vaccinated vs coronavirus; 561K receive booster shots

MANILA, Philippines — Some 38.7 million Filipinos have been fully vaccinated against coronavirus in the nine months since the government first launched its inoculation campaign.

This is equivalent to 35.49% of the population — less than half of the 90% that health experts stress must be fully vaccinated to attain herd immunity in the country.

Of those fully vaccinated, some 561,135 — 0.51% of the total population — have received a booster shot, according to Department of Health figures as of December 6.

Nearly half of these jabs — 259,504 — were administered in Metro Manila. The latest DOH figures show that 67.8% of the capital region's population has been fully vaccinated.

The rollout of booster doses for the elderly, healthcare workers, and those with weakened immune systems began last month but was expanded to include eligible adults just last week.

Meanwhile, another 53.49% million or 49.06% of Filipinos have received the first shot of a two-dose regimen.

In the last seven days, officials have administered a daily average of 1.26 million doses, inching closer to their daily target of 1.5 million shots.

The government will launch a second mass vaccination drive next week, targeting to administer a total of 7 million doses.

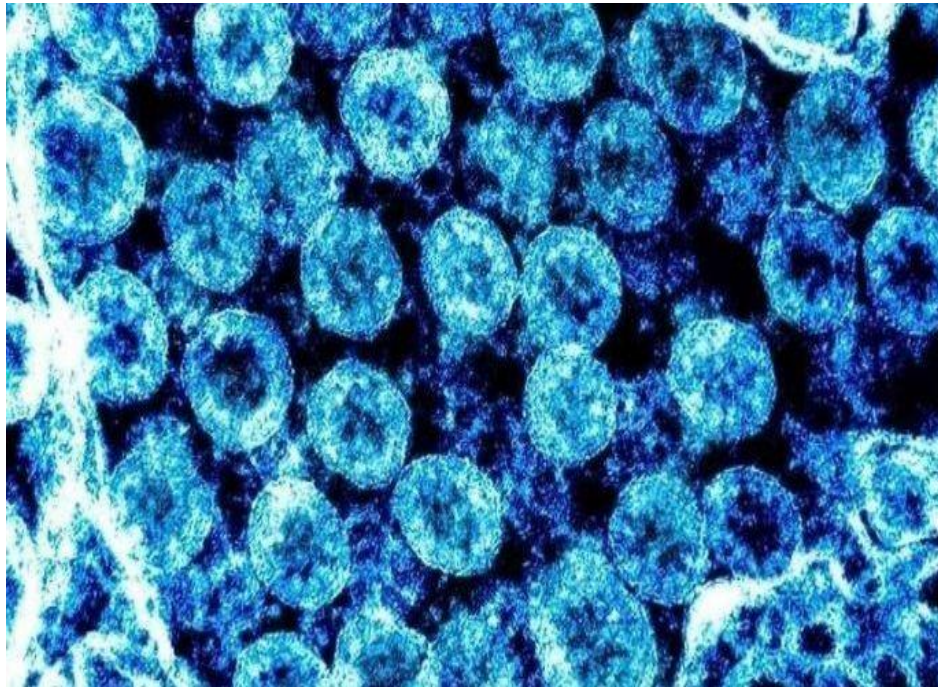
Its initial drive, held from November 30 to December 2, saw the inoculation of eight million people, short of the nine million that officials initially targeted.

MANILA, Philippines — Pinaniniwalaan ng independent OCTA Research Group na dobleng mas nakakahawa umano ang bagong Omicron variant kaysa sa Delta variant ng COVID-19 base sa datos na lumalabas mula sa South Africa.

Sinabi ni Dr. Guido David, fellow ng OCTA, na dalawang beses na mas maaaring maipasa ang COVID-19 Omicron variant na nananalasa ngayon sa South Africa at mga karatig na bansa.

“Reproduction number in South Africa shows an increase to  $R_t=4$  based on our own SIR (susceptible-infectious-removed) model. In previous surges, the reproduction number increased to less than  $R_t=2$ ,” ayon kay David.

Sa simpleng interpretasyon, nangangahulugan ito na ang Omicron ay kayang makapaghawa ng 10 hanggang 16 na tao sa mas mabilis na panahon ng pagkakalantad sa isang taong infected nito.

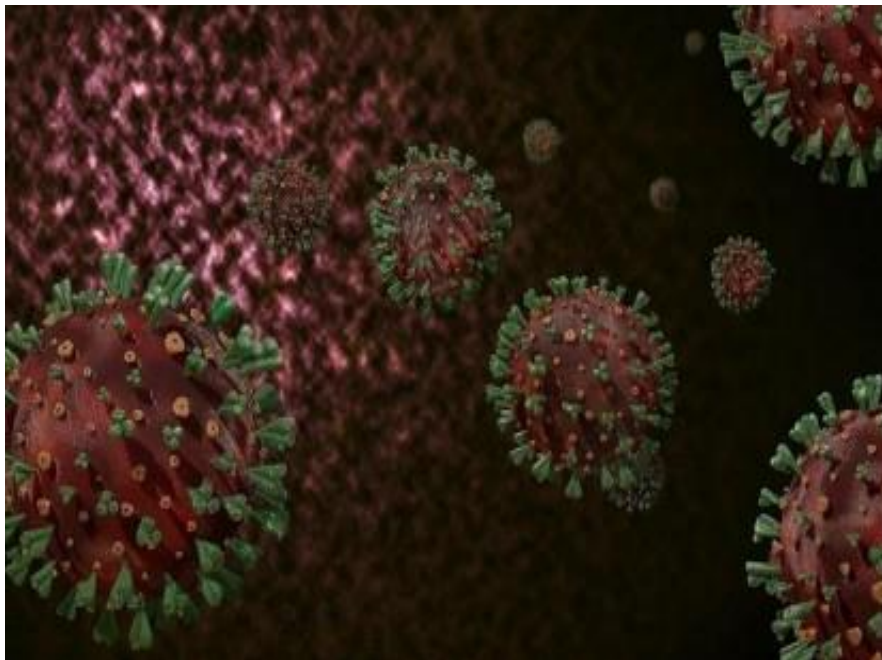
Nitong Sabado, inilathala ng South African Medical Research Council ang isang ulat ng biglaang pagtaas ng mga kaso ng COVID-19 sa Tshwane district sa probinsya ng Gauteng kung saan nalagpasan na ng Omicron ang Delta variant.

Ngunit hindi naman ito nagdulot ng pagtaas sa bilang ng mga naospital dahil sa mababang bilang ng mga nagkakaroon ng pulmonya dulot ng virus.



## Omicron spreading via community transmission in UK: official

**LONDON** – British Health Secretary Sajid Javid told parliament Monday that the Omicron coronavirus variant is now spreading in the UK through community transmission rather than solely via people who have traveled to Britain from abroad.

He said there was now a total of 336 cases of Omicron in the country -- 261 in England, 71 in Scotland and four in Wales.

"This includes cases with no links to international travel, so we can conclude there is now community transmission across multiple regions of England," Javid said.

He warned that he could not guarantee that Omicron would not "knock us off our road to recovery."

Javid said from 4 a.m. Tuesday, both vaccinated and unvaccinated travelers from non-red list countries to Britain would have to show a negative Covid-19 test from the previous 48 hours before departing.

He also noted that Nigeria has been added to the red list.

The UK recorded 51,459 new cases of Covid-19 on Monday, bringing the total number of cases since the start of the pandemic to over 10.5 million.

There were also 41 deaths recorded across the UK over the past 24 hours, bringing the total since the start of the pandemic to 145,646.

Up to and including Dec. 5, 2021, 88.9 percent of Brits aged 12 and over had received their first dose, 81 percent their second, and 35.8 percent their booster or third dose. (*Anadolu*)

## Covid: Early signs Omicron spreads more easily, says No 10

**Early signs suggest the Omicron Covid variant is more transmissible than the current Delta strain, No 10 has said.**

But the prime minister's official spokesman added it was still too early to draw conclusions - and any impact caused by Omicron would also depend on whether it caused severe illness.

There are currently 437 confirmed cases of Omicron in the UK, [figures show](#).

Earlier, Wales' health minister said [they were expecting a significant wave of Omicron](#) that would peak in January.

In Scotland, Covid rules [are going to be reviewed daily](#) as Omicron cases rise, and First Minister Nicola Sturgeon has urged employers to let staff work from home until at least the middle of January where possible.

Scientists believe Omicron could spread more easily than Delta, and could out-compete Delta to become the dominant variant in the UK.

But much is still unknown, and it could still take weeks to understand how severe illness from the variant is and what it means for the effectiveness of vaccines.

The variant is currently spreading in the community in multiple areas of England, Health Secretary Sajid Javid said on Monday.

The government's cabinet was given an update on the pandemic on Tuesday morning.

Giving an account of the meeting afterwards, the PM's spokesman said: "The prime minister said it was too early to draw conclusions on the characteristics of Omicron but early indications were that it is more transmissible than Delta."

But he said there was "no hard agreement on the level of transmissibility", and it was "too early to tell" the effect on vaccine evasion or seriousness of the illness it would cause.

The spokesman also said ministers did not discuss whether to introduce the government's "plan B" for winter - which could involve more restrictions if the pressure on the NHS becomes too much.

Officially there have been just over 400 Omicron infections. But that's just the tip of the iceberg.

It is based on positive tests sent to labs to check for variants, which only happens in a minority of cases.

Because of a quirk in the way Omicron shows on PCR tests it is possible to identify suspected cases too.

Using this data, researchers at the University of East Anglia believe there could have been five to six times as many Omicron cases as the official total shows.

This data is what is behind suggestions the number of cases is doubling every three days or so and the conclusion that it is more transmissible than Delta.

What is not clear is why. To what extent is it down to Omicron's ability to get past immunity, greater infectiousness or because it has a shorter incubation period?

The answer to that could have a big bearing on how quickly and how far infection levels will climb.

Another unknown is what that will mean for serious illness. You would expect reinfections or infections post-vaccination to be milder.

If that is the case, the proportion of cases ending up in hospital will drop.

But even if it halves, if infection rates more than double, pressure on the NHS will still increase.

The threat of hospitals being overwhelmed is now back on the table.

Earlier, Welsh health minister Eluned Morgan also said it was clear the Omicron variant spreads rapidly.



## Covid: Early signs Omicron spreads more easily, says No 10

Although there have been only five cases in Wales - compared with 333 in England, 99 in Scotland and [three in Northern Ireland](#) - Ms Morgan said people should act with caution.

"We are expecting a significant wave of Omicron to hit Wales," she said.

"The modelling suggests that that will reach its peak by around the end of January, which is why there is an urgency in terms of getting people vaccinated and boosters done as soon as possible."

Ms Sturgeon said about 4% of cases in Scotland appeared to be the Omicron variant, adding: "Our estimate at this stage is that the doubling time for Omicron cases may be as short as two to three days, and that the R number associated with the new variant may be well over two."

Although it is an early estimate based on limited data, a fast doubling time means cases can get high quickly. For example, three day doubling means going from 1,000 cases a day to about 100,000 cases a day in one month.

Why do new variants of Covid-19 keep appearing? BBC's health reporter Laura Foster explains

Omicron is the most heavily mutated version of coronavirus found so far.

It was first identified in South Africa, where there is now a surge in the number of people catching Covid multiple times.

This suggests the variant might be better at sidestepping some of the protection offered by vaccines, or past infection.

However, there is not definitive proof. Even if Omicron is more infectious, there is no evidence yet that it causes more serious illness.

The government is urging people to take up their booster jab when offered - or be vaccinated if they have not yet done so.

Speaking during a visit to a prison on Tuesday, Mr Johnson said the UK had now delivered more than 20 million boosters. "I would certainly say to people, now is the time to get it," he added.

On Tuesday [the government announced](#) there had been another 45,691 Covid cases and a further 180 people had died.

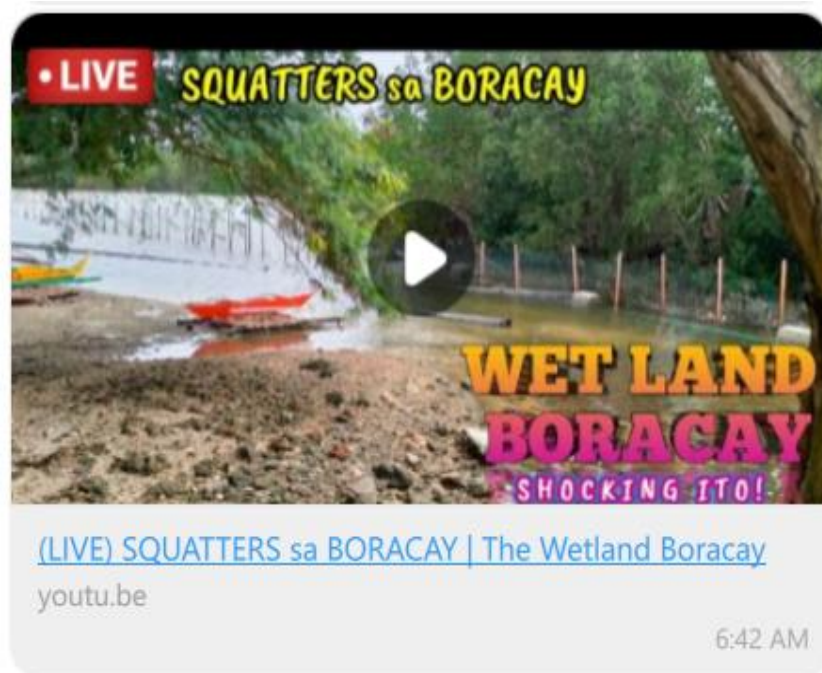

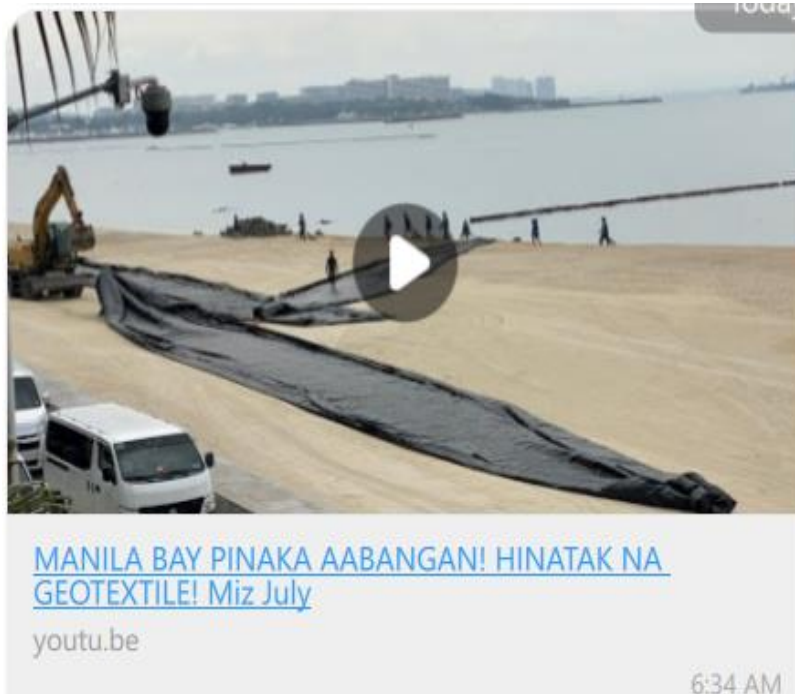
