### Bay cleanup nets pollutants

About 100 sacks of assorted trash were recovered from Manila Bay during a cleanup drive spearheaded by the Department of the Environment and Natural Resources at the Tanza Marine Tree Park in Navotas City.

Among the recovered items were plastic bottles and styrofoam food packaging materials that threaten the environment because they are not biodegradable.

Similar bay clearing operations were conducted by the DENR National Capital Region at Baseco Beach in Port Area, Manila.

Manuel Escasura, DENR NCR assistant regional director for management services, appealed to the public not to throw their wastes at bodies of water because they are pollutants and could result in floods.

# Fernando suspends mining in Bulacai

GOV. Daniel Fernando temporarily suspended all Some issues and concerns permits on mining, quarrying, of those in the mining sector dredging, desilting and other must also be threshed out types of mineral extractive immediately, including the operations as well as special permits for land development in Bulacan.

This was confirmed on Sunday by lawyer Juvic Degala, head of Bulacan Environment and Natural Resources Office (Benro).

"The governor issued Executive Order 21 on Aug. 16, 2022," Degala said.

Part of Section 2 is the Declaration of Policy which states that the provincial government will adopt measures to safeguard and conserve land, mineral, marine, forest, and other resources of the province.

All such permits shall be suspended pending the approval of the governor regarding the environmental sustainability of their operations pending inspection and evaluation.

Fernando suspended all permits to do an inventory of the resources in conjunction with sustainability of operations. He also wanted to ensure environmental protection and that the general welfare of the people are upheld.

adverse effects on operations of the high cost of fuel.

Fernando is also aware of the concerns of motorists on overloading and excessive volume caused by dilapidated roads, particularly along Manila North Road, or the former MacArthur Highway.

The suspension was also done to look into possible legislation that could improve the situation.

Katrina Anne Bernardo, head of the Provincial Public Affairs Office said, the law becomes effective upon the signing of the Executive Order, but the implementing office would inform the affected sectors first.

She added that the chief implementing office will be the Benro, but the final approval would come from the governor.

The sanctions for those found violating the EO will be P5,000 per violation and imprisonment of not less than six months and revocation of their business permits.

Marcos: Proposed ₱5.268-T budget for 2023 is for economic transformation

resident Marcos said his administration's proposed \$\P5.268\$-trillion national budget for 2023 is anchored on what he called the "Agenda for Prosperity"

that aims to achieve his medium-term macroeconomic and fiscal objectives.

In his message to Congress, Marcos said the objective of the largest proposed budget in Philippine history is economic transformation.

He added that the following goals

inspire the Agenda for Prosperity:

- 6.5-7.5 percent real gross domestic product (GDP) growth in 2022
- 6.5-8.0 percent real GDP growth annually between 2023 to 2028
- 9.0 percent or a single-digit poverty rate by 2028
- 3.0 percent National Government (NG) deficit-to-GDP ratio by 2028
- Less than 60 percent

 At least US\$4,256 gross national income (GNI) per capita or the attainment of upper-middleincome status

"These are, in fact, the measurable medium-term macroeconomic and fiscal objectives stipulated in this administration's Medium-Term Fiscal Framework (MTFF)," he said.

### **Economic transformation**

Marcos said the country's economy was severely affected by "various challenges beyond any leader's control," such as the Covid-19 pandemic and recent perilous typhoons like Typhoon "Odette" that ravaged parts of Mindanao in December 2021.

He also cited the 7-magnitude earthquake that rocked parts of Northern Luzon, particularly Abra, last month, and the Russia-Ukraine conflict that has triggered a global food crisis.

Against these challenges, Marcos said there is a need to transform the country's economy into a proactive one where people are prepared and economic gains could be achieved.

"We must meet our productivity goals regardless of the disasters and crises that may come our way," he said.

President Marcos said the Department of Health (DOH) had been given a 4.1-percent budget increase in preparation for further global health challenges. At the same time, the Department of National Defense (DND) received a 9.0-percent increase in anticipation of destructive typhoons and calamities.

The Department of Agriculture (DA), which Marcos leads, received an unprecedented increase of 43.9-percent for its programs and projects in anticipation of a global food crisis and the long-term goal of food self-sufficiency.

Meanwhile, the Build, Build, Build, Build infrastructure program will be maintained at 5.0-6.0 percent of GDP. The Department of Transportation (DOTr) received a budget increase of 120.4 percent so it can move "full speed ahead" on improving the country's transportation infrastructure.

partment of Agrarian Reform (DAR), is poised to receive ₱184.1 billion.

Lastly, the DOTr will receive a budget of ₱167.1 billion. This will cover the augmented funding requirements for various foreign-assisted railway projects.

## Allocation for other agencies

Based on the President's message, the administration proposed the following 2023 budget allocations for these departments, programs, and sectors:

- Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE): ₱26.2 billion
- Department of Migrant Workers (DMW): ₱15.2 billion
- Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps): ₱115.6 billion
- Educational assistance and subsidies: ₱54.9 billion

Moving toward green governance, the Marcos administration is proposing \$\mathbb{P}\$453.1 billion for "climate change expenditures of implementing units," such as projects for sustainable energy and environmental stability.

"All these programs will be supported by the proposed National Expenditure Program to propel our nation's economic transformation and achieve our Agenda for Prosperity," President Marcos said.

Meanwhile, allocations to local government units (LGUs) will amount to ₱962.2 billion or 18.3 percent of the proposed budget.

On the other hand, ₱582.3 billion, or 11.1 percent of the proposed budget, will be used to pay for obligations to the government's creditors.

### Assumptions

In his message, President Marcos said the administration hopes to sustain a 6.5–8.0-percent growth from 2023 to 2028. This comes with 17.6 percent of GDP by 2028.

"Such growth will reflect the expected recovery in the global economy and the anticipated decline in global oil prices," he

"We hope to achieve this through tax policies and tax administration reforms," he added.

### **Priority sectors**

The Education sector received the most significant chunk of the proposed 2023 national budget with ₱852.8 billion, an 8.2-percent increase from its 2022 funding.

Public Works received \$\mathbb{P}718.4\$ billion to continue the Build, Build, Build program and fuel the Build, Better, More program that is seen to generate more jobs.

The Health Sector will receive ₱296.3 billion as the country continues to address the pandemic and expand its healthcare systems to the regions.

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) will receive ₱197 billion to address the needs of the poor and marginalized.

The Agriculture Sector, which comprises the DA, its attached agencies, and the DeThe Development Budget Coordination Committee (DBCC) projects the debt-to-GDP ratio of the National Government to decrease from this year's estimate of 61.8 percent of GDP to reach less than 60 percent by 2025 and to further decline to 51.1 percent by 2028.

"By 2028, we intend to pass on an economy that bears no traces of the negative effects of the pandemic," Marcos said.

The President likewise announced his eight-point socioeconomic agenda:

- Food security
- Improved transportation
- Affordable and clean energy
- Healthcare
- Social services
- Education
- Bureaucratic efficiency
- Sound fiscal management


