Procurement of One (1) Lot Hyper-Converged Infrastructure (HCI)
Servers for the Department of Environment and Natural Resources Central Office (DENR-CO)

1. RATIONALE

The DENR network infrastructure has been made to accommodate the growing number of information systems users and the increasing volume of electronic information accessed and stored daily. End-User demands a fast and resilient server infrastructure. Furthermore, the DENR's information system services also require additional computing capacity.

To make the operation of the server infrastructure more efficient, the DENR Knowledge and Information Systems Service (KISS) through its Network Infrastructure Management Division (NIMD) has embarked on the acquisition of additional server infrastructure technology in the form of a Hyper-Converged Infrastructure. Replacing legacy infrastructure consisting of separate servers, storage networks, and storage arrays by leveraging the capabilities of a virtualized environment. Powered by a distributed software layer, it eliminates common pain points associated with legacy infrastructure such as large space requirements and multiple management interfaces. Through this procurement, the DENR will benefit in terms of system availability, agility, maximized computing resources, scalability, and ease of management.

II. APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT

The total ABC for the project is <u>PHP14,970,000.00</u> inclusive of all applicable government taxes and service charges.

C. Pre-implementation

Submission of <u>Method of Procedure (MOP)</u> shall indicate the methods or strategies to minimize the downtime. Once approved by the end-user, the installation, configuration, and testing shall follow.

D. Installation, Configuration, and Testing

The installation and configuration shall follow what is written in the MOP. Any deviation by the winning bidder's technical team during the execution of the MOP should be coordinated with the End-User. It is the End-User's discretion if such deviations are considered minor or major. Revision of the MOP shall be required on such deviations for another round of review and approval.

Note: The End-User shall ensure that all required documents submitted by the winning bidder for approval shall not exceed three (3) calendar days without approval. If no action on the submitted documents is taken by the end-user within the period above-mentioned will not count against the overall deadline period.

VI. PERIOD AND PLACE OF DELIVERY

Installation, configuration, and testing will be at the DENR Server Room located on the 6th flr. of the abovementioned building. All within ten (10) calendar days after the Project Kick-off meeting.
