Subscription of Network Performance Monitoring Software of Department of Environment and Natural Resources-Central Office (DENR-CO)

I. RATIONALE

The DENR Central Office finds it necessary to oversee the operation of computer network to ensure availability and overall performance of hosts and network services. With technology innovation and the rise in connected devices, today's IT environments are growing in size. The use of network monitoring solutions facilitates smoother operations of complex IT architectures and ensures that everything stays in balance with optional functionality. This will not only save time and resources, but also reduces data center overhead and ensures network availability at all times.

II. APPROVED BUDGET OF THE CONTRACT

The total ABC for the project is <u>PhP 2,500,000.00</u> inclusive of all applicable government taxes and service charges.

III. PROVIDER'S QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- A. Service provider must have at least five (5) years' experience in providing similar (Maintenance subscription of Network Monitoring Software) services and should provide proof accompanied by correspondence from referees indicating that such project was executed as well as their contactable references.
- B. Service provider must have the capacity and ability to provide maintenance services and technical support.

IV. SCOPE OF WORK

- A. Subscription, installation, and testing of Network Monitoring Tool at the NIMD of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources-Central Office, Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City within thirty (30) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP).
- B. Configuration of DENR network dashboard maps for at least 5000 devices.
- C. Integration of the existing network monitoring of regional offices to be able to monitor using the new network monitoring tool.

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V. QUALIFICATION OF BIDDER

The following requirement must be provided during post qualification:

- A. The principal and the reseller should both have ISO 27001 certification for their internal processes and certificate must be provided;
- B. Certificate of Registration under the Department of Information Communication Technology through Cybersecurity;
- C. Platinum Membership Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PHILGEPS).
- D. The service provider should have at least two (2) engineers who are certified in Network Monitoring; he/she must be a regular employee and has been working under the Service Provider for at least two (2) years prior to the submission of the proposal. Must submit valid certification from SSS, Certificate of Employment, CV and company ID.

VI. PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

A. General Technical Requirements

- 1. Web Interface
 - Unified Dashboards with configurable options for network monitoring and management including Network, Server, Storage, Cloud, VMs, CCTV, Wireless, etc.
 - Network Diagram
 - Live and Static Maps
 - Built-in Diagnostic Tools
 - Multi-tenancy and Role-based access capacity
 - Real-time/Offline Reports

2. Discovery

- Automated and Continuous
- Supports SNMP (v1, v2c, v3), HTTP, SMTP, POP3, JMX, SOAP, REST API, PDC, SSH and Telnet
- Discover Primary and Secondary line connected to DC

3. Fault Management

- Filtering, De-duplication, Holding Suppression and Correlation capabilities
- Multi-level (preferably six-level) Severity definition
- Sends alerts via E-mail, SMS, Execute Batch file, SNMP Trap, XML notification, Popup window, and Audio alerts
- The tool should have a bi-directional option to integrate with Network Configuration and Change Management (NCCM) features easily. The integration should allow assets and topology to sync from the NMS module to the NCCM features for helping in Root-Cause-Analysis of faults;

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- The tool should have built in algorithms to start the monitoring with zero threshold configurations, all thresholds within the tool should have a set point, reset point, polarity, setpoint message and reset point message for ease of use;
- Monitors traffic from all the interfaces of the network device. Provides traffic Utilization based on individual interface and nodes level or based on the group by location, branch, departments etc. as an Avg, Min and Max bandwidth, utilization, throughput or any custom monitoring parameters;
- The tool should provide many different types of visual representation. To perform the following:
 - Display physical connections of the different devices being monitored in the system
 - > Display flat maps of the entire network or networks in a single view
 - Display customer maps based on user configurations
 - Display maps based on geo locations
- Provision to draw & map user specific network diagrams and should also support Drag & Drop based Network Diagram builder, Dynamically Upload Images, Customizable objects to support multiple vendors, capability to export maps in an XML format and upload to any other system.

B. Installation and configuration

- 1. Installation and configuration of software.
- 2. Integration/migration of existing map to winning service provider's monitoring software.
- Setup seamless inter connection from DENR infrastructure to the networking monitoring software.

C. Testing

The acceptance test procedure shall be in accordance with the following:

- The acceptance testing will be undertaken for a period of one (1) calendar day and will be attested to by NIMD personnel.
- 2.) During the testing period, the service provider shall not be held liable for performance degradation/interruptions that are beyond its control such as power outages, fluctuations or failure or malfunction of DENR-CO's own equipment.

D. Maintenance

- Provide a single point of contact for customer support.
- Shall respond to request for maintenance at no cost DENR during the warranty subscription period.
- 3. Installation of software updates, upgrades and/or patches if available.

E. Certificate of Subscription

The winning service provider must provide a certificate of subscription in favor of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) which shall indicate the following:

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- 1. Product Name and Description.
- 2. Validity Period for Subscription (Start and End date of subscription).
- 3. 8 x 5 Email and Phone Support during the validity period.
- 4. Support for Upgrades or Updates during the validity period.
- 5. Other Terms and Conditions (if any).

VII. TERMS OF PAYMENT

DENR shall pay the winning service provider for its services only after the issuance of Certificate of Completion. The payments for the services will be done in three (3) tranches as stated in the table below.
