Dear Mr. President:

We would like to respectfully inform the President that due to the ongoing and the forecasted rainfall today, July 24, 2024 which will bring moderate to heavy rains over Metro Manila caused by the Southwest Monsoon enhanced by Typhoon CARINA (I.N. "GAEMI"), the NDRRMC recommends the suspension of classes and work in government offices within the National Capital Region (NCR) **effective 5:00 AM, July 24, 2024 (Wednesday).**

Likewise, the same course of action for private companies, offices and schools is left to the discretion of their respective heads. This excludes frontline agencies engaged in emergency services.

The recommended suspension will prevent any untoward incidents and will ensure the safety of the general public.
