TERMS OF REFERENCE

As of 10 July 2024

Procurement of Cisco Network Switches for the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR)

I. RATIONALE

The DENR Network infrastructure has been made to accommodate the growing number of computing users and increasing volume of electronic information accessed and stored daily. End-user demands a fast and resilient network infrastructure. Furthermore, the DENR's current network equipment and devices are outdated and obsolete and have already reached End-of-life and End-of-Support.

In view of this and taking into consideration the emergence of security threats among institutions and government agencies, it is recommended to have a network refresh and rehabilitation to improve network performance and security and support the department's network and critical applications.

In response, the DENR Knowledge and Information Systems Service (KISS) through its Network Infrastructure Management Division (NIMD) has embarked on the acquisition of a new, secure and responsive network infrastructure with the upgrade of network switches. This will also ensure reliability and improve longevity and capacity of the network to support the ever growing demands in information technology of the department.

II. APPROVED BUDGET OF THE CONTRACT

The total ABC for the project is PhP11,900,000.00 inclusive of all applicable government taxes and service charges.

III. SCOPE OF WORK

Supply, delivery, configuration and testing of sixteen (16) brand-new Cisco Switches for the Regional Office and three (3) Access Switch for the Central Office (Civil Service, Multi-Purpose and Annex Building).

IV. BIDDER'S QUALIFICATION

- A. Must have at least five (5) years' experience in providing similar contracts (supply and delivery of Network Switches) with attached proof accompanied by correspondence from references indicating date of execution of contract as well as their contactable references.
- B. Service provider must be a Cisco System Integrator for at least seven (7) years in the Philippines.

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- C. Must be an authorized partner of Cisco Systems Inc. and must be supported by a Certification from the manufacturer's local office.
- D. Service providers must have at least two (2) Cisco Certified Network Associates CCNA Routing & Switching who are regular and locally based employees. They must submit a certificate of Cisco Network Associates and company ID with certification of their HR Department that they are employees.

Note: Technical Evaluation shall be based on the documents submitted such as, but not limited to brochures and technical data sheet to be submitted during post-qualification within five (5) calendar days from receipt of Notice from the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) declaring the bidder as having the lowest or single calculated bid.

B. Delivery Period and other deliverables

- The winning bidder shall supply and deliver core and access switches at the DENR Central Office, through Property and Supply Management Division (PSMD) Supply Management Section (SMS) located at Basement, DENR Main Building, Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City within ninety (90) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP).
- Winning bidder must provide a <u>Warranty Certificate</u> valid for a minimum of one (1) year and in favor of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources which shall cover the following:
 - a. Hardware (parts and service), subscription and technical support.

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- b. Software/firmware upgrade and updates.
- Full replacement of defective items and materials including parts and labor, free of charge.
- Support during the warranty period
 - a. Single point of contact for customer support.
 - b. 8x5 Email, phone and remote support.
 - c. Shall respond to request for corrective maintenance at no cost to DENR.
- 4. Configuration and Testing
 - a. The switch is to be configured as required by the Network team of the DENR-CO.
 - b. The testing will be undertaken for a period of one (1) calendar day and will be attested to by NIMD personnel.
 - c. If any of the foregoing conditions are not met, the count of the testing period shall be restarted until all conditions have been duly satisfied continuously for one (1) calendar day.
 - d. During the testing period, the winning bidder will not be held liable for performance degradation/interruptions that are beyond its control such as power outages and malfunction of DENR's own equipment
