INVITATION TO THE 2025 CHEVENING SCHOLARSHIP

PROGRAM

This refers to an email from Ms. Ayesha Sarapuddin, Climate Change and Environment Officer, Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office, British Embassy Manila dated 08 October 2024, regarding the call for application for 2025 Chevening Scholarships which will start in September/October 2025.

Chevening is the UK Government's global awards programme aimed at developing future leaders and influences by offering fully-funded scholarships and fellowships to study in the UK. Chevening Scholarships are awarded to individuals with demonstrable leadership potential who also have a strong academic background.

The scholarship offers full financial support to study any eligible master's degree at any UK university. It aims to enhance technical skills and knowledge on sustainability topics to address emerging priorities related to climate adaptation, blue economy, and just energy transition, among others. Chevening application must list three courses and must be courses that are eligible for a Chevening Scholarship. To find a course, please visit the https://www.chevening.org/scholarships/find-a-course/.

Related to this, an applicant shall possess the following qualification requirements of the DENR:

- 1. Must be holding a permanent plantilla position for at least two (2) years in the DENR at the time of application;
- 2. Has obtained performance ratings of at least Very Satisfactory for the last two (2) consecutive rating periods;
- 3. Has been performing duties and responsibilities relevant to the field of study/travel being applied for;
- 4. Has no pending administrative case;
- 5. Has no pending application and nomination for other study and non-study trips;
- 6. Has not exceeded four (4) official foreign travel within a year;
- 7. Has submitted all the required reports from previous foreign travels;
- 8. Has rendered the required service obligation for a scholarship/training previously enjoyed;
- 9. Must be willing to sign a scholarship service contract and shall serve the DENR with the corresponding period of service obligation;

- 10. Must not be a delinquent scholar; and
- 11. In good mental and physical health.

Qualified candidates shall submit their complete application requirements to the Career Development Division through this link <u>bit.ly/nomiforeign</u> and/or QR code **not later** than Wednesday, 23 October 2024:



- 1. Memorandum addressed to the Chair of the Human Resource Development Committee (HRDC), attention HRDC Secretariat to be endorsed by Head of Office and concurred by Supervising Undersecretary and Assistant Secretary;
- 2. Service Record;
- 3. Certificate of no pending administrative case:
- 4. Certification from the Director supervising human resources/Assistant Regional Director for Management Service/Assistant Director (Region/Bureau/Attached Agency) stating that the applicant:
 - a. has no pending scholarship nomination;
 - b. has not been a delinquent scholar from a previous scholarship grant;
 - c. has submitted all the required reports from previous foreign travels.
- 5. Updated Personal Data Sheet, with Work Experience Sheet, duly signed by authorized person administering oath; and
- 6. Self Certification of official Travel History for the past 24 months;

The DENR HRDC shall screen and select a qualified candidate to the program. Selected candidates will be notified and endorsed to the British Embassy to proceed with the application process.

Deadline of application to the Chevening Scholarship is **on or before 05 November 2024.** Should you need further information about the requirements, please communicate with the HRDC Secretariat at email address: hrdcs2020@gmail.com or telephone: (02) 8927-9107 or VOIP 1063.







Application timeline

Applications open at 12:00 UTC

5 November 2024



Applications close at 11:59 UTC/ GMT

The deadline for applications is 5 November 2024 at 11:59 UTC/ GMT (midday UK time).

From 6 November 2024

Applications are sifted against eligibility criteria.

19 February 2025

References and education documents deadline

Shortlisted candidates will be requested to submit two references and their education documents prior to their interview date. Read about what we require from your references.

26 February to 25 April 2025



Interviews take place

Candidates from all over the world are interviewed by panels at British embassies and high commissions.

Mid-November 2024 to January 2025



Reading committee assessments

Independent reading committees assess all eligible applications. Their scores and rankings are then passed back to local British embassies/high commissions.

Mid-February 2025

Applicants shortlisted for interviews

Once the embassy/high commission has reviewed the applications that were passed on to them, they produce a shortlist of those who they will invite to interview. Notifications will then follow. Congratulations if you make it this far. To prepare for your interview, please read our interview guidance.

From June 2025



Results


After months of preparation and trepidation, successful candidates will experience jubilation when interview results are announced from June onwards.

11 July 2025

Offer deadline

The deadline to receive and submit at least one unconditional UK university offer is 17:00 BST (UK time) on 11 July 2025.
